Blesma have developed a community programme based around encouraging young people to adapt and achieve in the face of adversity. During an extended assembly for the whole of Year 10, Pat told the story of how he lost parts of his limbs when deployed in Northern Ireland. He explained how he had to rebuild his life and learn how to take the

positives from any situation, an incredibly moving story which had a big impact on the students.

*Ashley Mitchell* had a huge challenge of running with senior boys for his 800m - his first lap was very quick, which I think was a result of Ashley stepping up his game against the seniors. He managed to keep this fast pace for his second lap and this was fab to see. He ran a personal best of 2:11m which was just shy of County standard, but on the plus side this is still 3 seconds quicker than he ran it on Sports Day.

*Josh Rowe* had a gruelling 7.5 laps to complete and he did this with great determination. Prior to this he had spent the last two weeks practicing this event in every PE lesson and had even cut out fizzy drinks to help him prepare with the day. He came a respectable 8<sup>th</sup> and ran quicker on his last lap than any other.

Well done to *Fabia Cloke* for getting through to the next round. She threw a personal best of well over 8m and has been the only Honiton student to progress through to the next round.

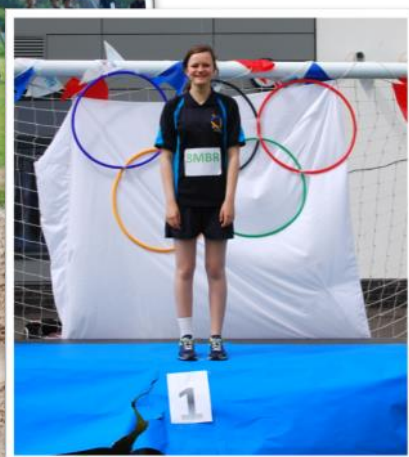


### Sports Day: 8 June
