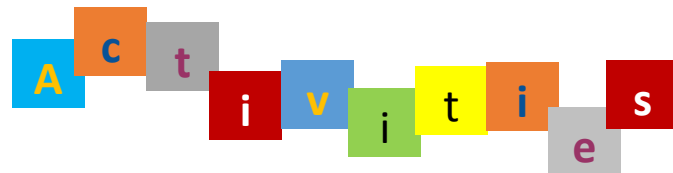
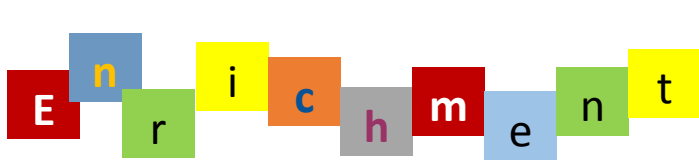
Visit to SCAT

Year 11 GCSE students visited Somerset College of Art, Design and Technology in Taunton to take part in a sublimation printing workshop.



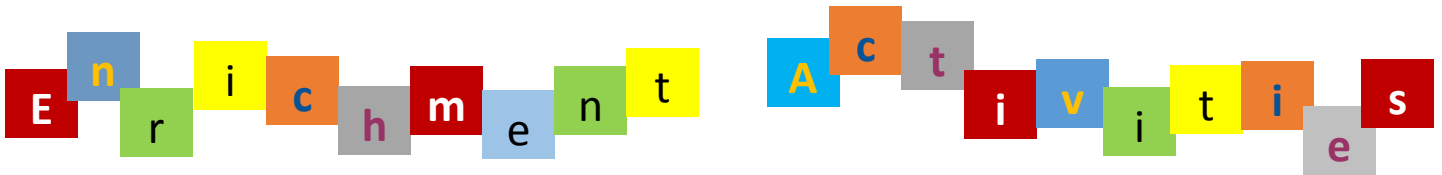

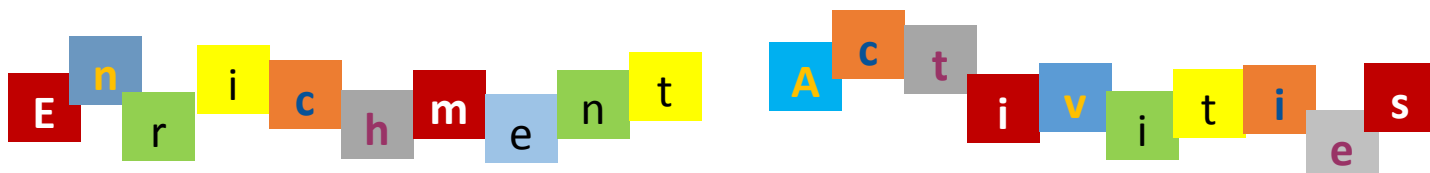
